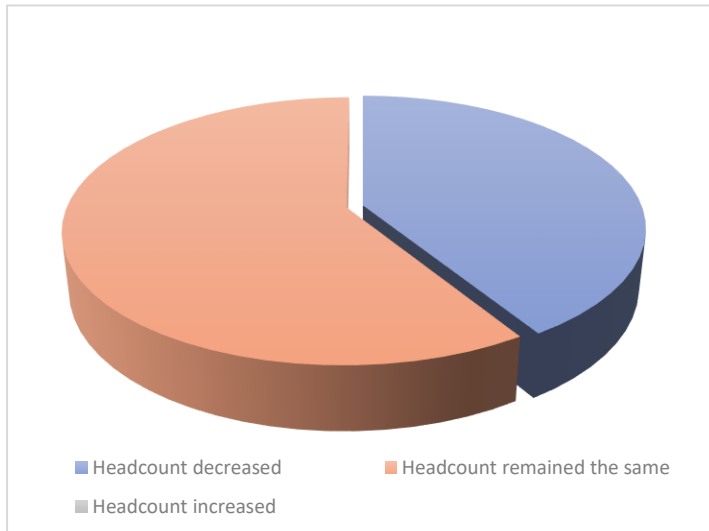


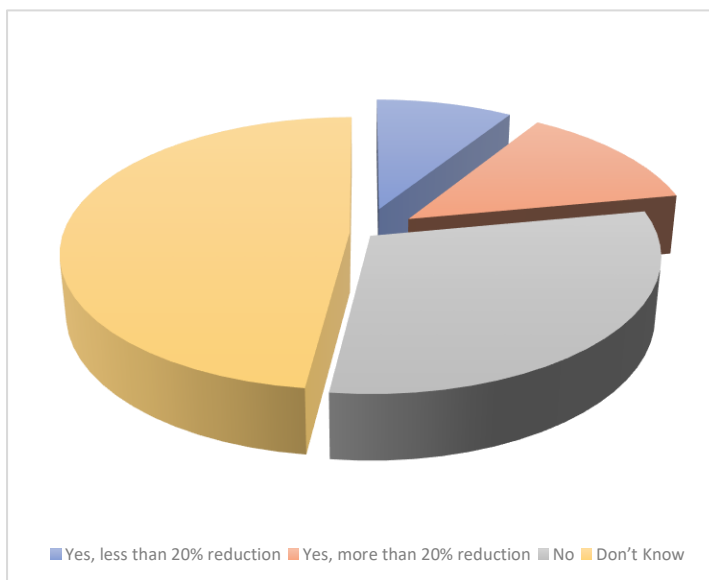
Research Results: Working in Higher Education post-Covid 19

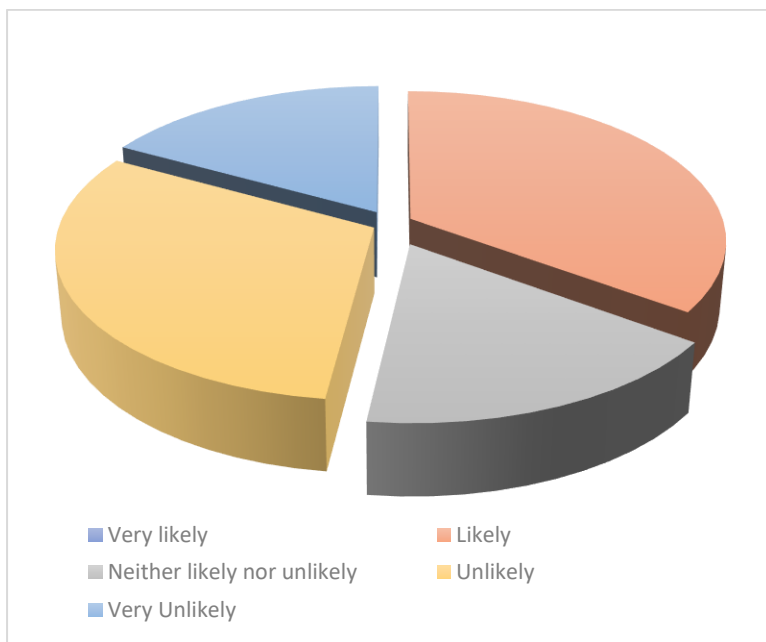
2. Has new student recruitment been affected by Covid 19?

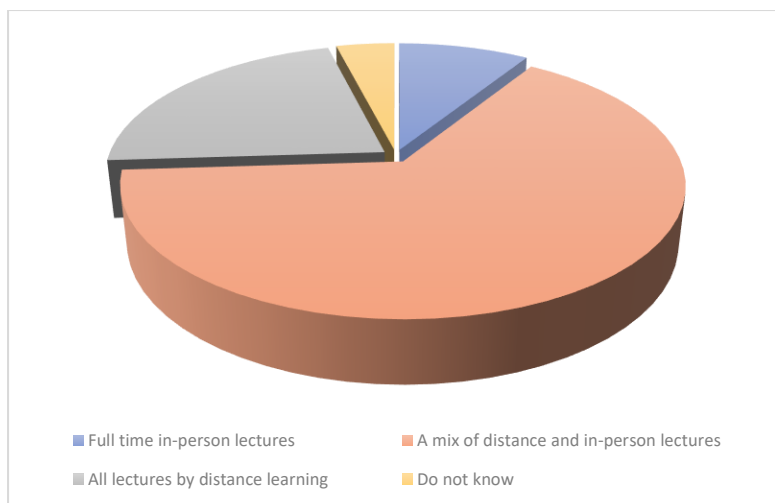


3. Thinking about the first semester of 2020/21 do you expect in-person lectures to take place?



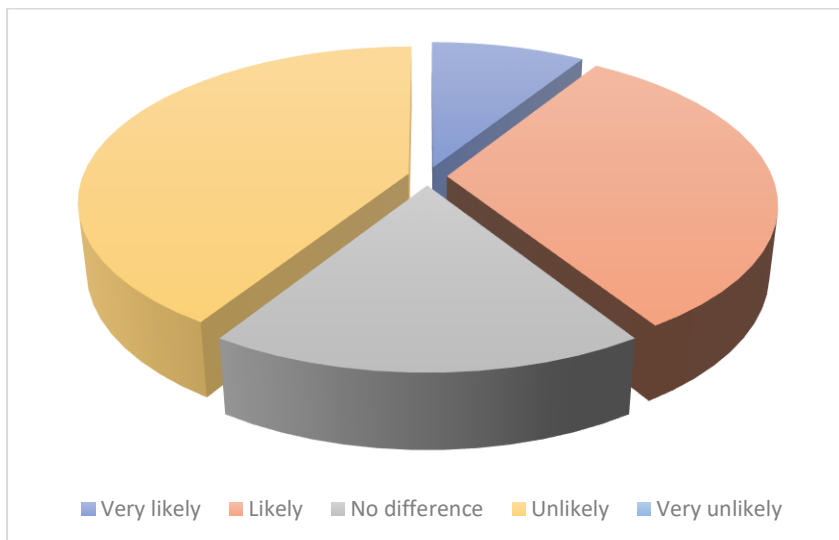

4. For the remainder of the academic year are you expecting in-person lectures to take place



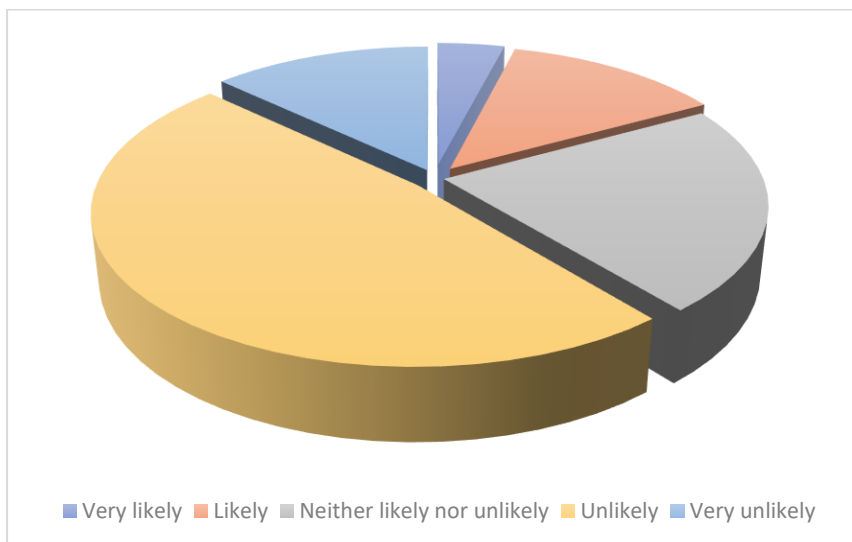

5. Do you think that with the proposed changes it will be as easy to deliver quality Higher Education than it was before?



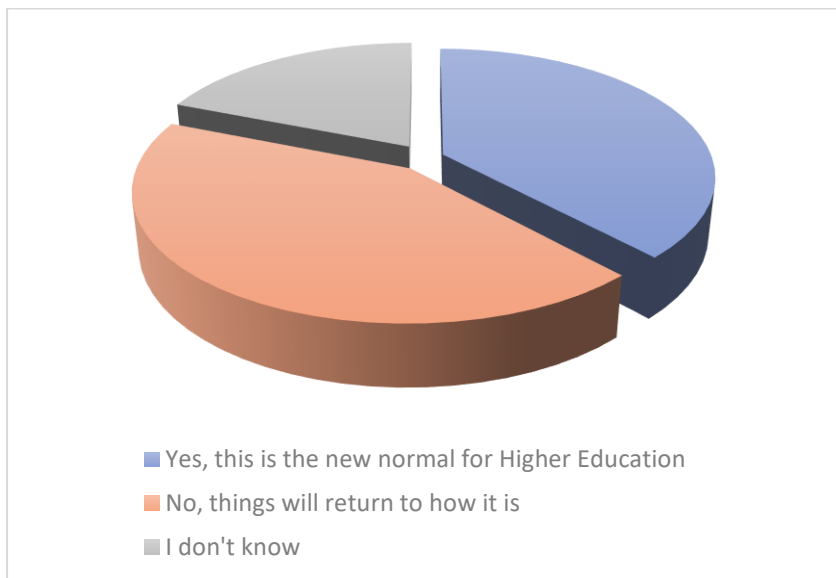

6. Do you think that students will get the same experience from Higher Education as they did before the pandemic?



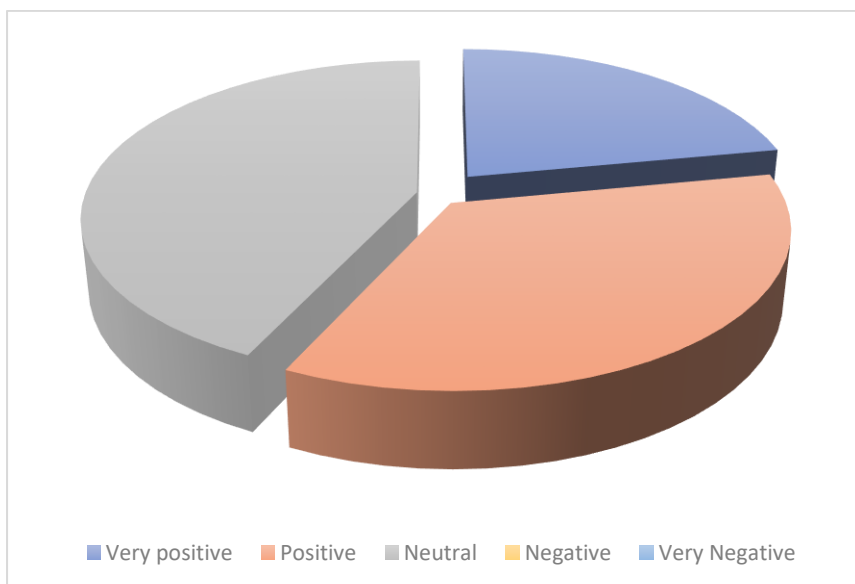
